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This will be a very special trip to Southern California including the famous Pageant of the Masters and Festival of the Arts in Laguna Beach.

Of course, we'll enjoy the wonderful Pageant of the Masters and the Festival of the Arts in Laguna Beach. Since the first painting was created here in 1878, the exquisite natural beauty of Laguna Beach has been a magnet for artists. Years ago the Laguna Art Association was established by the community to promote and support the fine arts. The Pageant of the Masters, the crown jewel of the festival, is made up of local residents in costume who imitate famous paintings and bring them to life.



We'll also visit famous Olvera Street, the actual birthplace of the City of Los Angeles, also known as El Pueblo Historic Monument. The original pueblo was built by the 44 settlers of Los Angeles in 1781. This colorful village features 27 historic buildings with a traditional Mexican style plaza area. We can wander around the marketplace and shop for souvenirs including handcrafted Mexican wares.

We'll stop in Hollywood at the Highland Center and see Mann Grauman's Chinese Theater and the Hollywood Walk of Fame for a taste of movie magic then and now. Perhaps we'll even catch a glimpse of someone we've seen on the silver screen!



We'll enjoy TWO cruises - one to beautiful Catalina Island with time to explore the quaint city of Avalon and the surrounding area. The second is a Harbor Cruise capturing the Historic Dana Point area.



We'll also see the Griffith Observatory with its unique architecture and setting, compelling programmatic offerings, and cinematic exposure making it one of the most famous and visited landmarks in southern California. Walk around inside the building, view the live planetarium shows, or simply gaze out towards the coast and the heavens.

We'll enjoy a tour of the ancient and beautiful Mission San Juan Capistrano, where the swallows seem to return year after year. This monument dates to 1776 and offers 10 acres of gardens, fountains and structures that played such an integral part of California History. Its chapel is the oldest building in California still in use, having been built in 1782. Mission San Juan Capistrano has served as a favorite subject for many notable artists, and has been immortalized in literature and on film numerous times, perhaps more than any other mission.
